






Peter Mantell has recently acquired some Pitney Bowes specimen 'proofs' from 1972. The item here (serial prefix P.B.L) has the indicia block modified in such a way that two vertical lines appear through "GREAT BRITAIN" and "POSTAGE PAID", and two horizontal lines through the crown and the serial. The full image, with hand-written comments alongside the artwork, is shown below, together with two similar examples with the serial prefix P.B.A.

Next month the FC511 and N105 series are due for retirement from this list.




Latest Number Images

Note that the item below is the first FM265 series to be reported using the Design J format.












Greg Spring sends this black and white slogan from the Royal National Institute for the Blind.




Peter Mantell sends this coloured slogan from JLT Investment Services in Exeter.








